A Message from the Rector

Dear Church Family,

I am writing to let you know the difficult news that Cn. Tracey was recently diagnosed with breast cancer. She kindly agreed that I could write this short note to you all.

The medical team believes that her longterm prognosis is good. However, it is serious, she will require surgery to remove a mass and then four months of chemotherapy followed, probably, by a course of radiation therapy in the New Year and none of those things will be easy.

She will be taking time out from her work in the diocese and province as Canon for Youth Ministry. Here at Christ Church we have also taken her off the preaching and leading schedule until the New Year and we are working on a plan for youth ministry too. It may be, that from time to time, she feels well enough to lead services or attend work and on those occasions she will step in on her terms if she wants to but without expectations from us.

I love our staff team. Their first instinct was to pray and weep with her and then to start thinking about how they might help. I love our leadership and our wider body for frequently demonstrating the very same instincts too and I know that you will be upholding her in prayer and wanting to know what you can do. We will be sharing information later in the year on how you can help the family practically if you'd like to.

Feel free to speak to Tracey about this openly but please also understand that sharing a difficult story multiple times as a public person can be tiring and hard.
