2019 Giving Update

Thank you to those who have returned their Intention of Giving cards in person, by mail or online.


Almost all of our church income comes from congregational giving, so completing a card (printed or virtual) is the most useful way to help plan next year's budget. Your pledges determine whether we may do abundantly more kingdom ministry or must reduce the scale and quality of our church's work.

Please submit your information by November 5.



Some useful information:

- the budget is drafted in November, finalized in December and presented at the Annual Meeting in January
- 90% of our church income comes from congregational giving
- we don't ask for a specific amount but a tithe (10% of income) is a biblically normative amount
- based on attendance, it costs about \$70 per person a week to operate our church
- based on membership, it costs about \$35 per person a week to operate our church
