Our Abundant Response

How your giving impacts the 2019 budget

Nearly all of our income comes from congregational giving, so completing a card (printed or virtual) is the most useful way to help plan next year's budget. Your pledges determine whether we may do abundantly more kingdom ministry or must reduce the scale and quality of our church's work.

Some useful information:

- the budget is drafted in November, finalized in December and presented at the Annual Meeting in January
- 90% of our income comes from congregational giving
 - we don't ask for a specific amount but a tithe (10% of income) is a biblically normative amount
- based on attendance, it costs about \$70/person a week to operate our church
- based on membership, it costs about \$35/person a week to operate our church
