



## 2018 Tax Year Giving Deadline: Dec. 31

Please note the following to ensure that funds you would like to apply to the 2018 tax year are recorded in your account:

- recorded in your account:
  In Person: must ARRIVE
  (i.e. be placed in offering plate
  or dropped off at the office)
- no later than 12/31/18
   By Mail: be postmarked no later than 12/31/18

For those who fulfill their 2018 pledge after Dec. 31: please write "2018" on your check or envelope so that it is applied to the correct year in our internal records.

Please note: all funds received in 2019, even if they are intended to fulfill a 2018 pledge, are not able to be applied to the 2018 tax year and will not be included in your year-end statement for 2018.
